School-Age Children* – Ages 6-13

Each day, teachers will provide daily learning experiences in math, science and/or literacy through special educational activities to help keep your child's mind sharp – all summer long! Arts/Crafts Camp

From art that the children create on their own to special projects led by our staff, this session will open up the world of artistic expression. Getting messy with paint or creative with wood sticks and glue, each child can make something that tells a little about themselves or their group. And while having fun, the children learn how to use real materials and objects with different textures. We will hone children's critical thinking and problem-solving skills while they create a group masterpiece.

Sports Camp

From learning the skills of a sport to benefiting from the exercise involved in team play, the children will participate in numerous physical activities. Whether enjoying a hula hoop on their own to flag football with their friends, numerous options are provided to enjoy the wide world of sports. In addition to the healthy attributes of playing outdoor games, children will learn what its like to be part of a team, as well as developing small and large motor skills. Children will have the opportunity to apply math and language skills in a real life situation as they invent their own sporting event.

Nature Camp

We will explore the natural world we live in. From plants and trees to the oceans and sky above. What does nature have to offer us and what we can we do to make sure that we are offering right back? The children will learn about "going green" and what that means in daily life. Through study and experimentation as well as group investigation, they will learn about the needs of living things and processes of the natural world. We will call upon children to use their science knowledge and planning ability as they plan and create a community garden.

Music/Dance Camp

Jumping on a stage and singing along to a favorite tune. Doing the two-step with your best friend. Learning how to play a musical instrument. For this session, children will move to music and explore their singing voice. They'll create an instrument and play it to a rhythm and beat that they came up with. Just like art they make with their hands, in the world of music and dance, they will create art with their mind and heart, and get everyone grooving to the beat. And we will challenge children's investigative and construction skills as they build their own music-making device.

Animal Camp

You may have a pet or been to a zoo ... but how much do you really know about the animals of earth? The children will look at animals and their environments. How they live and where. The animals of the oceans and lakes, the desert and forest. Animals that are fuzzy and animals that have scales. The children will be taught the needs of healthy pets and explore the topics of wild life extinction and conservation. Over the course of the session, children will blend science with math and art as they each create a scale model of their favorite animal.

Cooking Camp

Who is in the kitchen? Probably everyone because who doesn't love food? Through cooking projects, children will participate in math and measurements. The children will also examine healthy choices and options, and the relationship between good health and smart selections. In addition to food as "fuel for life," kids will learn how they can make meal preparation an art form while studying cultural heritage. Children will use teamwork and planning skills throughout this session.

Drama Camp

Children learn a lot about themselves when they pretend to be other people. So in this session they will write plays, act out scenes from the classics, and end the summer with our annual talent show. Props and costumes help them explore different time periods and cultures. They can also experience what its like to be a grown-up or maybe act like they are in a profession they hope to occupy as adults. Over the course of the session, children will all take on roles as they write, plan for, and put on a show of their own.

Science Camp

During this session children will participate in inquiry-based activities that strengthen critical thinking skills and challenge them to learn more. Students will work in teams to investigate hands-on experiments that help them pursue the why-factor of wonder, discovery, and exploration. Activities will engage students in observation, measurement, identification of properties, and experimentation involving life, earth and physical science concepts. Children will also have the opportunity to participate in a science showcase at the end of the session.
