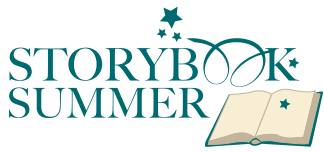
Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten Programs Ages 3-5 years
