### Click it, Sculpt it, Paint it

Campers learn to work with their hands and minds gaining appreciation of form and the value of artistic creation. You can create art in many forms like photography, sculpture or students can explore more traditional forms like painting. From art that the children create on their own to special projects led by our staff, this session will open up the world of artistic expression. Getting messy with paint, working with clay or exploring photography, each child can create something that tells a little about themselves. Kids will be exposed to a variety of artists and cultures as they learn about art concepts and methods. A long-term project will give children the opportunity to create a group mural.

### Fantastic Sportastic

Sports are fun. And even more fun when you practice and get better. Campers will have a great time as they gain new skills and make new friends. From learning the rules of a sport to benefiting from the exercise involved in team play, kids will participate in numerous physical activities. In addition to the healthy attributes of playing outdoor games, children will learn what its like to be part of a team, as well as develop small and large motor skills. As a long-term project, children will have the opportunity to apply math and language skills in real life situations as they create the La Petite Olympics.

### Environmental Experiences

We will explore the natural world we live in. From plants and trees to the oceans and the sky above. What does nature have to offer us? And what we can we do to make sure that we are offering right back. The children will learn about “going green” and what that means in daily life. Through study and experimentation as well as group investigation, they will study the needs of living things and processes of the natural world. A long-term project will call upon children to use their science knowledge and planning ability as they plan and create a community garden.

### Musical Masterpieces

Does your child always have music on her mind? If so you will love this dancing/musical themed camp. Students will learn about various types of dances and be able to practice them. They will also be able to learn about a variety of music genres. Students will use their creativity and teamwork skills for the long-term project as they create instruments for each child to use in the classroom band.

### **Creature Feature**

You may have a pet or been to a zoo ... but how much do you really know about the animals of earth? Children will look at animals and their environments; how do they live and where? What makes a mammal a mammal and not a bird? How do scales help a snake move? Children will uncover these and many other animal mysteries as they examine fur, feathers, skin and scales from around the globe. Children will be taught the needs of healthy pets and explore the topics of wildlife extinction and conservation. Over the course of the session, children will blend science with math and art as they work together to build a zoo display in the classroom.

### **Fun with Cooking**

Who is in the kitchen? Probably everyone because who does not love food? Through cooking projects, the children will participate in math and measurements. Also the children will examine healthy choices and options and the relationship between good health and smart selections. In addition to food as "fuel for life", kids will participate in how they can make meal preparation an art form as well as a study in cultural heritage. Children will use teamwork and planning skills as they take on this session's food-related long-term project.

### **Destination Science**

Destination Science combines the fascination and curiosity for science with the excitement of outdoor summer activities, ensuring that every camp day is memorable. Children will use their mega-mind powers to explore fizzy soda pop reactions, attempt to conquer the forces of gravity as it pulls with all its might and learn all about the history of the dinosaurs. Children will have the opportunity to participate in experiments, learn about weather, and discover robot science. The large project will have students creating and adapting a Mega-bot until it ultimately takes on the characteristics of its creator!

### **Act it Out**

The curtain is going up...on a camp filled with the excitement and magic of theater! Does your child dream of standing in the spotlight on opening night, or seeing himself on television? Is she always performing even when there is no audience? Children learn a lot about themselves when they pretend to be other people. So in this session they will write plays, act out scenes from the classics and perform for their friends.
